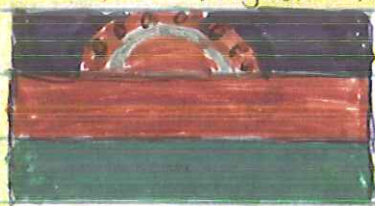
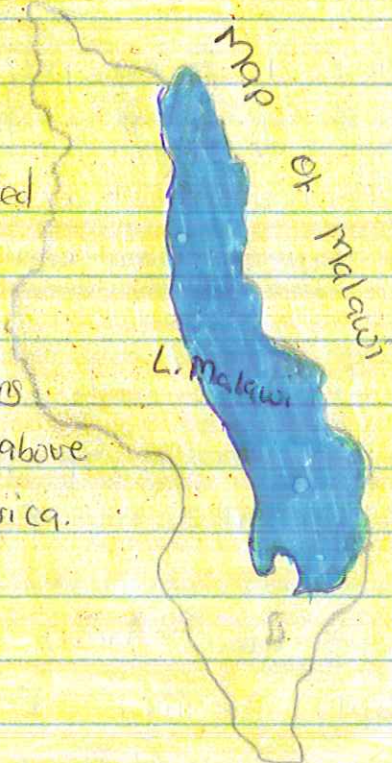

My name is Veronica am in form 2 which is second year at secondary level. And am 13 years old. I come from Nkhosatots, (one of the district in Malawi)

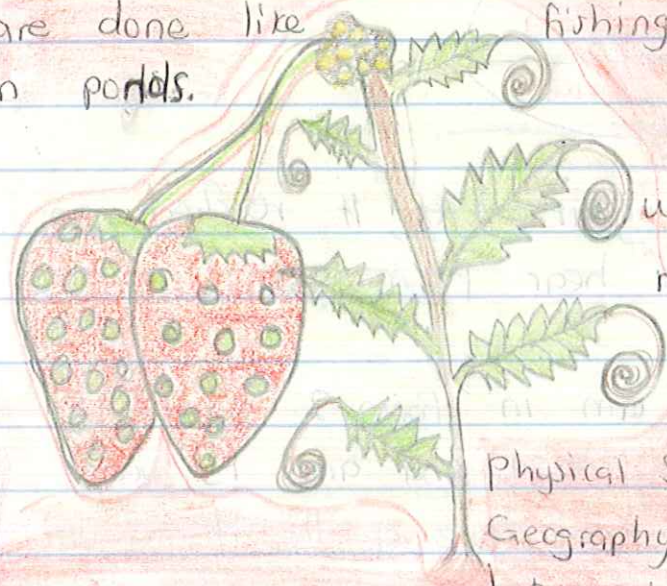
